

DOG AND PUPPY TRAINING CLASSES AT PRCKC

ELIGIBILITY

- Adult Dog Class
 - 6 months or older
 - MUST be spayed/neutered
 - MUST be UTD on vaccines
 - Client must provide vet records if they are not a PRCKC client/if services were given at another clinic (I prefer records to be emailed to me directly – bwasinger@prckc.org). I accept PDFs, screenshots, or photos of printed documents)
- Puppy Classes
 - 3-6 months old
 - MUST be UTD on vaccines
 - Do not need to be spayed/neutered
 - Client must provide vet records if they are not a PRCKC client/if services were given at another clinic (I prefer records to be emailed to me directly – bwasinger@prckc.org). I accept PDFs, screenshots, or photos of printed documents)

FEES

- \$50 for a 5-week session.
- Enrollment fee MUST be paid in advance in order to enroll. In other words, we can't hold a spot for you – you have to pay to get a spot in class.
- Financial assistance is available and can be determined on a case-by-case basis.

CLASS DETAILS

- All classes are 5-week sessions.

- Puppy Manners, Level 1 and 2 with Jean Wells
 - Tuesdays, 6-7:30 pm
 - The first day of class is a meeting between the trainer and the pet owners. DO NOT bring your dog to the 1st class.
 - Topics: Basic commands, leash manners, social skills
- Puppy Basics with Ben Olson
 - Wednesdays, 6-7 pm
 - Bring your puppy to every class!
 - Basic commands, leash skills, social skills, some care skills (tolerating nail trims, etc.)
- What to bring:
 - Your dog's leash and collar or harness (harness preferred)
 - Your dog's favorite treats, small pieces (cut up hot dogs also work really well) – needs to be something very motivating/exciting that your dog will work hard for
